## **Marillion**

**Live in Bristol for the first time in 10 years.**

Tickets for this one-off concert are **£15** and **go on sale at 10am on Thursday May 12th** and are only available from the St George's Bristol Box Office on **0117 923 0359** or by going to the Box Office at St George's Bristol, Great George Street (off Park Street), Bristol, BS1 5RR.

Marillion have been recording and playing live for over twenty years and this concert will be a rare opportunity to see Marillion play an acoustic set with stripped down arrangements of their back catalogue.

Hosting Marillion is a real coup for St George's Bristol as this concert will be one of only a few UK concerts played by the band before they head off for a tour of North America during June.

Often seen as unfashionable by the mainstream music press Marillion have thrived in the age of the internet. The production and promotion of their last two albums, 'Anoraknophobia' and 'Marbles' was funded by over 12,000 of their fans pre-ordering the CD's before they had been recorded.

As the many thousands of fans who regularly flock to see the band live or who buy their records are all too aware, there really is no other band like Marillion. They refuse to compromise their music by bowing to marketing pressures, focus groups or record labels seeking a chart-busting single. Marillion have pressed on to create their own unmistakable and unique music whilst amassing a huge "underground" following around the world.
